



## SPECIAL INITIATIVE GRANT

Designed to support Provincial Sport Organizations (PSO), Regional Sport Councils and universities with hosting **coaching or officiating initiatives** (e.g., seminars, workshops, mentorship, development of grassroots coaches or officials' program, etc.)

- This grant is **not** to be used for travel outside of Manitoba.
- This grant is **not** to be used for National Coaching Certification Program opportunities.

### Funding

- Approved initiatives with a budget of up to \$1000 are eligible for a maximum grant of \$500.
- Approved initiatives with a budget greater than \$1000 will be cost shared 50:50 between Sport Manitoba Coaching and the PSO/RSC (e.g., sponsorship, registration fees, PSO contribution, etc.) to a maximum of \$1000 per fiscal year per sport.

Example:	<u>Budget</u>	<u>SMC Contribution</u>	<u>PSO Contribution</u>
	\$300	\$300	\$0
	\$600	\$500	\$100
	\$1000	\$500	\$500
	\$1500	\$750	\$750
	\$4000	\$1000	\$3000

- The total of all Special Initiative grants must not exceed \$1000 per year per PSO/RSC (i.e. organizations may apply for multiple grants, provided the total of all approved grants does not exceed \$1000 per year per PSO/RSC.)
- Note: each PSO/RSC is not guaranteed the full \$1000/year.
- Sport Manitoba Coaching **must** be recognized as a funding partner on all promotional material.
- Should your actual expenses be lower than the amounts on your proposed budget, the grant amount may be adjusted accordingly.

### Application submission information

- Notification of grants will be given approximately 14 working days following application submission date.
- Short notice applications will be considered on a case-by-case basis, if budget allows.
- Evaluation of proposals will be based on the value it has to the development of coaches or officials in Manitoba within the context of the sport.
- Grants will be paid following the submission of a post-event Sport Manitoba Coaching Invoice.
